Twin Reefs

Twin Reefs is approximately 3.7 kilometres from Cape Paterson towards Inverloch. From the cliff-top car park you can wend your way down to the shore platform. No fossil bones have been found at this locality, but it has some of the best examples of freshwater crustacean burrows.
