We also have a new Chairman/President in Ron Burge who will lead our club for the next couple of years. Board meetings have continued on a monthly basis during the winter months.

Snippets from recent Board Meetings.

- The Board is formalising roles within committees to eventually produce an "Operations Manual" for use within the club which will include job descriptions.
- A "New Member" welcome kit is being prepared to give to new members joining the Inverloch Bowling Club.
- Eight new bowling arms have been purchased with grant money. These will
 be available on a "loan" basis to members wishing to try out the use of an
 "arm".
- Letter to Inverloch Lions Club thanking them for \$2,000 donation.
- Update of recently formalised catering quote forms.
- Try Bowls Day arranged for Sunday October 19th, 11.00am 2.00pm.
- Approval given to member driven investigation into possibility and cost of installing a synthetic green.
- Weekly Friday night "jackpot" draw to commence with season opening.
 Winner decided by numbered membership cards, must be present to collect.
- Member volunteer forms have been returned and are being analysed and prepared for allocation of jobs – good response and thanks from Board.
- Our club has been represented at SGBA delegates meetings and the Annual Meeting.
- It was decided that membership subs must be paid before September 1st to be eligible to play in pre season pennant practice matches.

Grants

The Board of Management has been continually sourcing small grants whenever they become available.

Recent successful applications include:

Installation of Solar Panels \$5,000 (Bass Coast Shire)
Replacement of kitchen utensils \$2.275 (Federal Gov)
New bowling arms for "loan" to members \$1,560 (Vic Health Active Club)

Water saving-new building project \$ 500 (S.G.Water Board)
Replacement of fence and new entrance gates

Total in hand \$17,413

Current grant applications:

New "Zip Boil" unit for kitchen \$1,500 (Bass Coast Shire)

Work in progress application:

Grant towards new building renovation \$7000 - \$10,000 (Dept Veteran Affairs)

As can be seen from the above details every opportunity is being taken to apply for funds when ever grant monies are being made available from the various sources. So far the amount of time and effort in preparing grant applications has proved successful, it is hoped we may "snare' a sizeable grant in the near future.
