Building Update – No. 2

developments in relation to the Clubrooms upgrade and renovation project. It now seems almost certain that the lease over our existing site will be renewed. We are meeting with the Bass Coast Shire Officers on December 12th to discuss the detail of the proposed new lease, including the lease term (21 years requested), the rental and any special conditions. Once the detail of the new lease is agreed between the Shire and the Club the proposal will then be submitted to the Department of Sustainability and Environment for formal sign-off. On November 21st, together with President Nic Van grunsven we met at the Bowling Club with the Minister for Sport and Recreation, Hugh Delahunty and our local member Ken Smith to discuss the availability of a State Government grant to assist with the financing of our project. This was a positive meeting and whilst no promises were forthcoming the Minister provided us with some guidance and encouraged us to proceed with an application once our lease is renewed. Also, Neil and Jack have been working with Lumei Project Managers and David Gaskin Designs to have the design drawings updated for stages 1 and 2 of the upgrade. The updated drawings have now been completed and are available for viewing. Our main focus over the last few months has been to get our lease renewed as this is the key factor limiting the progress of our upgrade project. This is now within grasp and once completed we are well placed to move ahead with the actual renovations.
