FRIDAY NIGHT MEALS



Board Meeting Snippets.

- An application by the Board to the Bass Coast Shire for a Community Grant towards the installation of solar panels has been successful and as a result we will receive the maximum \$5,000 grant. Information will now be sought on the equipment type most suitable for our premises.
- During recent months the Board has worked on formalising a procedure for the nomination for Life Membership and has signed off on these documents at the last Board Meeting. The paperwork will be available for members to view in the coming weeks and will provide a formalised method not previously in place.
- At present there is a vacancy on the Board due to the resignation of Ron Kee and the Board is presently working on filling the vacancy. Ron, as you would be aware, was Greens Director and the Board is at present handling this position through President Nic Van Grunsven and Vice President Ron Burge.
- A new wall mounted key storage unit is being purchased to provide a safe storage area for a number of important keys used in the premises, except the Bar keys which will remain with the Bar staff.
- Two Board members met recently with our Bar supplier, Monacellars, to re-negotiate rebates and sponsorship. As a result we received goods to the value of \$800 and a further \$200 payment for signage above the footy tipping board. In addition to this we negotiated with Monacellars an arrangement whereby members can use their current membership card at the drive through bottle shop at Duncans (Whalebone Hotel Wonthaggi) and receive a 20% discount on any wine purchased. The club will also receive a benefit in our trading arrangement with Monacellars.
- The Board would like to remind members of the Inverloch Bowling Club "Code of Conduct" put in place last year. A copy of this document is on display on the notice board.
- Members are reminded that annual membership subscription renewals have been issued and if not already paid should be done so now to enable you to be eligible to use the club facilities.
